Conclusion of Agreement on OTC Drug Marketing Rights with DER UAW PHARMACEUTICAL CO., LTD.

KYORIN Rimedio Co., Ltd. (head office: Kanazawa City, Ishikawa Prefecture; President and CEO: Hiroshi Hashizume; hereinafter "KYORIN Rimedio"), a subsidiary of KYORIN Holdings, Inc. (head office: Chiyoda-ku, Tokyo; President and CEO: Minoru Hogawa), has concluded an agreement concerning the rights to market over-the-counter drugs in Taiwan with DER UAW PHARMACEUTICAL CO., LTD. (head office: Taipei, Taiwan; President: Te-Chang Hsieh; hereinafter "DER UAW Pharmaceutical").

Based on the agreement, KYORIN Rimedio grants DER UAW Pharmaceutical the rights to market six OTC drugs in Taiwan. DER UAW Pharmaceutical will apply for the registration of the six products for import and sales with the Taiwanese authorities. DER UAW Pharmaceutical will supply the products to drugstores centered on those operated by JAPAN MEDICAL CO., LTD., its affiliate, following their approval.

KYORIN Rimedio aims to secure marketing channels for OTC drugs in Taiwan with the conclusion of the agreement as an opportunity. KYORIN Rimedio will further the supply of its drugs in Taiwan to contribute to the health of people around the world.

The impact from the conclusion of this agreement on KYORIN Holdings' consolidated operating results for the fiscal year ending March 31, 2019 is minor.
